INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN REGIONAL ASSESSOR TRAINING (KZN AND WESTERN CAPE ONLY)

Inseta invites interested stakeholders to attend assessor training that will be held in KZN and the Western Cape that will commence in June 2011. This assessor training is targeted at individuals who intend to assess learners against insurance sector related qualifications.

Individuals undergoing this five day assessor training will be credited against the unit standard **115753: “Conduct outcomes–based assessments”**.

Individuals credited with this unit standard will be able to :

- Demonstrate understanding of outcomes-based assessment
- Prepare for assessments
- Conduct assessments
- Provide feedback on assessments
- Review assessments

Applicants will need to meet the following criteria in order to be eligible to participate in this training :

- Have at least **3 -5 years relevant work** (occupational) experience in either short-term / long term insurance or the Wealth management field.
- Possess a relevant qualification at either **Short – Term Insurance NQF level 5** or **Wealth Management NQF level 5**
- Have at least **1 year’s facilitation** experience
- Applicants must be **proficient in the subject matter of the learning area** in which they wish to assess.
- Have good interpersonal skills and **must be able to communicate effectively** with learners.

Please Note:

- Delegates will be accommodated on a first-come-first-served basis when registering. Only shortlisted candidates who meet the selection criteria detailed above will be contacted to participate in training.
- There is no cost to attend this training. However, stakeholders attending training will be liable for their own travel and /or accommodation costs. Inseta will not reimburse stakeholder travel or accommodation costs.
- Inseta reserves the right to refuse latecomers or delegates who book after the registration deadline.
- On completion of training, candidates must register with the Inseta ETQA as constituent assessors.
