**Re: INSETA Funding Windows for Learnerships and Internships**

National Skills Development Strategy III (NSDS III) requires all of us to reconsider what we do and how we do it. At a Strategic Planning Session held on 19 October 2011, the board and management reviewed and agreed the areas in which INSETA must focus on for maximum impact for the sector and in line with our mandate and the NSDS III goals. INSETA's strategic plan in line with these new inputs is being updated and will be presented to the board for approval. Project motivations which give effect to the strategy will also be presented to the board for their approval during the last quarter of the INSETA financial year ending 31 March 2012.
