



## **FINANCIAL LITERACY PROGRAMME AND MENTORSHIP SKILLS FOR COOPERATIVE FINANCIAL INSTITUTION MEMBERS.**

The INSETA in collaboration with the University of Johannesburg are pleased to announce that they will be providing financial literacy workshops.

This exciting opportunity comes with an added advantage of mentorship skills on basic money management for small to medium and large businesses.

The workshop will follow a blended model using both online and contact sessions. This will involve Google classroom which will be used for online teaching and content, and two Saturday contact classes.

**Duration of training:** 12 full days.

The workshop will be held three times, so you have the option of selecting ONE of the following workshops offered

[\* all workshops will both cover the same material and content]

- **Workshop 1:** 4<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> October 2021:
  - Contact classes: Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> October 2021
- **Workshop 2:** 25<sup>th</sup> October-6<sup>th</sup> November 2021:
  - Contact classes: Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> October and 6<sup>th</sup> November 2021
- **Workshop 3:** 15<sup>th</sup> -27<sup>th</sup> November 2021
  - Contact Classes: Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> November 2021

**Scope of the training:** Theoretical and practical financial literacy skills.

- **Course preparation and provision:** A combination of study material and mentorship templates that can be used in their businesses.
- **Communication with the selected students:** Students selected will receive a selection letter via email (please ensure that you check your emails and junk folder so that you do not miss communication from us).
- **Certification:** Upon completion, students will receive attendance certificate and mentorship skills.

**Who qualifies:** Co-operative Financial Institutions members

**Important Dates:** *Closing date of the applications is **Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> September 2021.***

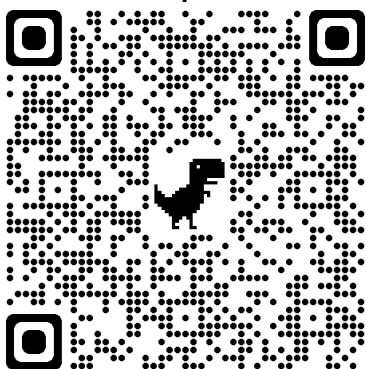
