IMPLEMENTATION OF A PILOT FOR FINAL INTEGRATED SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT (FISA)

Background

The QCTO is working towards the implementation of one Quality Assurance System for registered qualifications on the OQSF (Occupational Qualifications Sub-Framework). The QCTO is introducing Final Integrated Summative Assessments (FISA) for registered historical/legacy **full qualifications** that currently have learner enrolments.

The FISA is the evidence that must be produced by the learner against the required competencies in a qualification registered on the NQF. This assessment will ensure uniformity of final assessment against Skills Development Providers as the same assessments will be written by all learners enrolled against a qualification; applying the same knowledge and competency outcomes.

Discussion

As a QCTO-delegated Quality Assessment Partner (QAP), INSETA seeks to pilot FISAs for the for the following legacy qualifications:

1. Short-Term Insurance NQF Level 4 (49929)
2. Short-Term Insurance NQF Level 5 (57918)
3. Retail Insurance NQQ Level 4 (49835)

INSETA-Accredited Skills Development Providers that have learners (previously or currently) enrolled against the above-mentioned legacy qualifications and wish to be considered to participate in the FISA process, can do so by submitting a letter of intent to INSETA with the following details:

- a. Name of Skills Development Provider
- b. Qualification(s) to be considered for FISA
- c. Number of Learners to be entered for FISA per qualification
- d. Location of learners (Geographic area where learners can sit for FISA)

After consolidating the submissions, INSETA will advertise a procurement process to appoint Skills Development Providers that will participate in the FISA pilot project.

INSETA will be responsible for:

1. Funding of the implementation (hosting & invigilation) of FISA
2. Funding for the provision of FISA related administrative services
3. Provision of centralised script marking and moderation
4. Distribution of FISA instruments to appointed Skills Development Providers
5. Certification of successful candidates post FISA examinations
