INSETA invites relevant stakeholders to apply for Discretionary Grant funding for the 21/22 financial year to address the national priorities through skills development. Applications submitted for funding in support of learning programmes that lead to occupations that are hard to fill in the insurance sector as captured in the INSETA SSP will be prioritised. Please refer to INSETA website for the SSP and Critical Scarce Skills in the insurance sector for listed occupations. In addition, preference will be given to applications that aim to upskill and reskill the following groups: South African citizens working in the insurance sector, permanent residents employed in the insurance sector, women, unemployed Youth (including those in Rural communities), and person with disabilities.

The DG application window will be **opened from 19 April 2021 and close on 31 May 2021.**
