- North West

- Free State

The application window for 2021/22 Financial Year is now open from **15th April 2021 and applications will be accepted until 31st May 2021.**

Please Note:

1. Only INSETA registered employers (levy and non-levy paying) are eligible to apply (No applications directly from learners to INSETA will be considered)
2. Employers will be approved only subject to their compliance with the criteria set and the availability of funds; as INSETA would like to reach the stated provinces with these funded learnerships.
3. Only Learnerships that are addressing the Seta Critical Scarce Skills and Occupations that are on high demand (refer to www.inseta.org.za) will be considered
4. No Employer will be considered for funding outside the funding process.
5. INSETA will not fund any programme/s that the Employer commences before the approval of the application.
6. Previous track record for SETA funded programme will be considered (for those not applying for the first time) during the evaluation process of the application submitted.

The Completed and Signed (By Authorised Person) Expression of Interest must be forwarded to INSETA by the deadline date.
